

EFG - Code of Practice

The following Code of Practice adds general requirements for the work and collaboration of the contractual Parties.

1 - Dress Code

The SUPPLIER crew is supposed to wear non-branded working clothes for all EFG events. EFG may provide branded clothes (especially for operators) that the crew has to wear and will be appropriate for the working conditions. SUPPLIER has to provide the clothing sizes for the crew 21 days in advance of the first setup date. For any change after this deadline PARTNER has to bear the costs for the branded clothing.

2 - Social Media Use

The SUPPLIER must not publish any pictures or posts on any social media or web platform without prior written permission of EFG.

3 - Use of media

All media rights (pictures, films, gfx, broadcasts, etc) remain with EFG. Upon request EFG will provide media of an EFG event to SUPPLIER for internal use only. Any commercial use of EFG owned media including the use for promotional purposes for SUPPLIER or a supplier of SUPPLIER is prohibited. A special licence agreement can be closed if SUPPLIER wishes to use media for commercial purposes. The provision of this material may include costs that SUPPLIER has to bear.

Any and all use of the EFG marks and logos by SUPPLIER shall be subject to EFG's prior written approval (email shall be sufficient). Any and all public or commercial usage by SUPPLIER shall be prohibited. For the avoidance of doubt: Any rights not expressly granted to SUPPLIER according to the provisions of the Agreement remain solely with and are retained by EFG. The use by SUPPLIER of the EFG marks and logos shall be solely in connection with its exercise of the rights granted under the Agreement and subject to the terms and conditions thereof.

4 - Logistics

The SUPPLIER is fully responsible for shipping its material right on time. EFG has no responsibility for damages or late shippings.

5 - Security

SUPPLIER is obliged to report all crew members (including those from Sub-Contractors) to EFG. Upon request a clearance certificate needs to be presented on own costs of the SUPPLIER or the suppliers. All crew members may be searched upon entrance and leaving the production facilities by an authorised security person.

Crew members must wear their badge at all times and are only permitted to enter sections according to their badge. Guiding others is prohibited.

During setup, rehearsal, and teardown crew members must not take any pictures or films from the production site. Any violation may result in immediate confiscation of the camera/ smartphone and the crew member will be expelled from the production site. Any consequence of the expelling has to be borne by SUPPLIER.
